
	<b>PLANTING MIX 1 SMALL POCKETS OF PLANTING</b>  Stipa tenuissima Verbena bonariensis 'Purple Haze' Salvia sylvestris 'Crystal Blue'
	<b>PLANTING MIX 2 NARROW STRIPS ALONG THE ROAD SIDE</b>  Stipa arundinacea Helenium 'Moreheim Beauty' Crocosmia 'Emily MacKenzie'
	<b>PLANTING MIX 3 PLANTING ALONG ENTRANCE AVENUE</b>  Stipa tenuissima Verbena bonariensis 'Purple Haze' Salvia sylvestris 'Crystal Blue' Perovskia atriplicifolia 'Blue Spires'
	<b>PLANTING MIX 4 SEASONAL MIX CLOSE TO SEATING AREAS</b>  Verbena bonariensis 'Purple Haze' Salvia sylvestris 'Crystal Blue' Hydrangea paniculate 'Limelight' Hebe sutherlandii Viburnum davidii Peonies and roses in Later Living Unit gardens.
	<b>PLANTING MIX 5 SPECIES RICH AMENITY GRASSLAND including:</b>  Birdsfoot Trefoil, Black Meddock, Cowslip, Devil's Bit Scabious Eyebright, Field Scabious, Greater Trefoil, Kidney Vetch Lady's Bedstraw, Lesser Knapweed, Marjoram Meadow Buttercup, Mullein, Ox-eye Daisy, Ragged Robin Red Campion, Red Clover, Ribwort Plantain Rough Hawkbit, Salad Burnet, Selfheal St Johnswort, Wild Angelica, Wild Carrot Yarrow, Yellow Agrimony, Yellow Rattle, Orchid seed Night Scented stock and nicotiana (to promote night flying insects which would be of benefit to bats)  Annuals included: Corn Marigold, Corn Poppy, Corncockle Cornflower, Scented Mayweed
	<b>PLANTING MIX 6 WET SOIL MIX FOR RETENTION BASINS</b>  30% Sweet Grasses (Glyceria species) 20% Chewing Fescus 20% Perennial Ryegrass 30% Creeping Bentgrass (Agrostis stolonifera)
	<b>NEW NATIVE IRISH HEDGEROW</b>  Comprising 75% hawthorn and 25% of at least 4 of the following species; Blackthorn, Hazel, Guelder Rose, Dog Rose, White Privet, Willow, Honeysuckle and Elder
	<b>NEW HEDGING TO FORM PRIVACY BUFFER AGAINST BOUNDARY WALLS/RAILINGS.</b>  Evergreen to be Prunus lusitanica (Portuguese Laurel) and deciduous to be Fagus sylvatica (Beech) hedging
